As a friend to many people, a son to his parents and a brother to his siblings, he has a debt of mutual love that can only be met by the Holy Sacrifice of Mass. **Baptism Booking** Could parents please speak to Fr. The-Quang after Mass for booking. They are expected to show their commitment to the faith with their baptism certificate and reference from their Parish Priest who would certify their weekly mass attendance for at least six months. Only close family and godparents can come to the baptism. In line with the Government guidelines, facemasks must be worn by all attendees (excepting children under the age of 11, and those with medical exemption).
