COVID update

New guidelines from the Bishops for parishes in this 'post-lockdown' world:

- Hand sanitiser should remain available and its use be encouraged.
- Good ventilation remains important.
- Face masks continue to be worn.
- Cleaning of churches once a day is sufficient
- Church capacity can be increased up to 50% of capacity. 1m social distancing still applies.
- Indoor, congregational singing remains prohibited although small group singing is allowed, if essential, limited to groups of no more than 6.
- Church allowed to be open during the day for prayer

Acts of Worship

Stewards required only for Sunday Mass

- Track and trace methods should be available.
- The sign of peace remains suspended.
- Holy Communion remains under one kind. Communion on the tongue allowed, but those who wish to receive in that way should wait until the end of communion and hands should be sanitised.
- Concelebration allowed subject to guidelines.
- Offertory collections may resume but not by passing around.
- Baptisms – 30 people at a stand-alone celebration.
- Confirmation – capacity of church.
- Marriage – 30 people.
- Funerals – capacity of church.
- Sacrament of Reconciliation – use of confessionals permitted subject to adequate ventilation, appropriate cleaning and use of screening.

Home Visits – these are allowed but only two visits per Extraordinary Minister per day.

Parish Social Activities – these may resume subject to latest government guidance.

Catechetical Groups/Formation Groups/Prayer Groups – these may resume. No limit on number for under 18s. Over 18s limited to no more than 30.
