Prayer of the Faithful

Fr Simon writes: At a recent funeral of a Deacon friend, the Bishop said that the said Deacon had regretted spending 40 years teaching people (in RE) information *about* Jesus instead of helping them to *know* Jesus. That's a fair point- catechesis is important but especially in the culture we are now in, engagement with the heart is even more vital – evangelisation is foundational. Once people encounter the Lord, all the rest follows naturally. St Anselm (1033-1109, Archbishop of Canterbury from 1093) and our saint for the week, put it like this:

"I do not seek to understand in order to believe, but I believe in order that I may understand"

What happens in a Half-Day of Recollection? The format for these events at the Convent is that there is always a talk preceded by some prayer and worship. The guest speaker for the Half-day on 18th April is our very own Deacon Dominic. After a break for tea, there is Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. The Half-Day begins at 3 pm and ends just after 5 pm.

Term Dates and School Masses: Maryvale Catholic Primary School returns from its Easter Holiday on 13th April and so the Tuesday Mass will revert to being celebrated in the School Hall at the usual time of 09.30. The first Mass of the summer term is on 14th April at which Fr. Jude will preside. St Margaret Mary RC Junior and Infant School likewise returns on 13th April and the first School Mass will be in SMM church as usual at 09.15 on 15th April for Years 1 and 4. Christ the King Catholic Primary School returns on 20th April and so the Mass on Friday at 09.00 will be a Mass for Friday of the Second Week of Easter without the participation of the pupils and staff. Any parishioner is welcome to join any of the School Masses during the week.

Masses in the Convent: We are very grateful to Bishop David who is always willing to celebrate a Mass at 08.00 on Mondays and Wednesdays whenever his diary permits. From time to time, it is not possible to provide Mass in the Convent. **We try to give as much notice as we can but please help the Parish Office by making sure that you put your telephone number on the Mass intention envelope so that we can contact you directly.** If Mass in the Convent must be cancelled, then any Mass intention set for it will be rescheduled. **There will be no Mass in the Convent on either 20th or 22nd April** because Bishop David is at the Plenary Meeting of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

First Friday Masses in the Sacred Heart Chapel, Maryvale: the First Friday in April coincided with Good Friday which is one of the two days in the year when the Church never celebrates Holy Mass. The next First Friday Mass will be on 3rd May at the usual time of 7 pm.

Sycamore Talks at SMM: These take place in the Newman Gallery which is accessed via the steps at the back of the Church. Document on the Ordinariates: The Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith (a Department of the Vatican in Rome) has recently issued a document concerning the Ordinariates established under the Apostolic Constitution *Anglicanorum Coetibus*. The Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham of which Fr. Simon and Fr. Leonard and others in the Cluster are members is one such Ordinariate. The Prefect of the Dicastery (Cardinal Victor Manuel Fernández) has requested that the document be disseminated as widely as possible. There are copies at the back of each Church and more can always be requested from the Parish Office.

Retrouvaille Marriage Ministry: Retrouvaille is a marriage ministry, run by Catholics, to support marriages in trouble. It runs two programmes each year, catering to about 75 couples, who need help to find hope and healing in their relationship. The majority of couples find out about this ministry through parish newsletters and you might like to include the following in your bulletin: From relationships that are 'Just in a Rut', needing some refreshment or more serious issues - If you are open to try again – Retrouvaille could be the solution.
